LONDON TO PARIS AIR TOUR

It's time to grab your leather cap, goggles and silk scarf and join the fun as we embark on a cross country flight that will be reminiscent of the days of a bygone era. In the early 1900's the London to Paris Air Race was known world wide, as aviation captured the imagination of the civilized world.

Without crossing the Big Pond, this is probably the only place in the United States that could actually boast of a real honest to goodness London to Paris event. This isn't an EAA event, and it isn't a race. It's a fun air tour of central Kentucky. All pilots are responsible for observing all applicable FARs.

Short sleeve T-shirts (\$15) and long sleeve sweatshirts (\$20) will be for sale for those wishing to take home a souvenir of the adventure, and food will be available at the various airports throughout the day. All aircraft landing at all five air tour airports will be eligible for a **cash prize drawing!** Each airplane will be charged a \$20 entry fee and 100% of all entry fees will be redistributed as cash prizes.

The event is scheduled for **Saturday June 2nd 2007**, (June 3rd is the rain date), with pilots gathering at the London Airport (LOZ) at around 9:00 AM for a continental breakfast. At around 10:00 AM the flying will begin with the slower aircraft leaving first on a heading of 9 degrees, followed by the faster aircraft.

1) London (LOZ) - 9:00 AM (3 miles south of London)

2) Mount Sterling (IOB) - 11:00 AM (2 miles west of Mount Sterling)

AWOS: 120.675
To Paris: 312 degrees, 15.7 nm / 18.1 sm

2.5) Circle the Paris Courthouse, Counterclockwise, 1000 AGL or higher (No airport in Paris)

Lat/Long: 38-12-44.9000N / 084-14-14.5000W
38-12.748N / 084-14.242W
38.2124700 / -84.2373700
To 27K: 282 degrees, 9.1 nm / 10.5 sm

3) Georgetown (27K) - 12:00 PM (6 miles east of Georgetown)

CTAF: 123.0 Runway 03/21: 5500 x 100 ft.
AWOS: 119.975
To DVK: 207 degrees, 42.4 nm / 48.8 sm direct (contact LEX Approach on 120.15) or
174 degrees, 15.2 nm / 17.5 sm to OPLEE, then 223 degrees, 30.8 nm / 35.4 sm to DVK

Note: Remain clear of Lexington (LEX) Class C airspace, or contact Lexington Approach on 120.15.

4) Danville (DVK) - 2:00 PM (3 miles south of Danville)

CTAF: 122.8 Runway 12/30: 5000 x 75 ft.
AWOS: 128.325 Runway 01/19: 2357 x 75 ft.
To I39: 086 degrees, 21.1 nm / 24.3 sm

5) Richmond (I39) - 4:00 PM (8 miles southwest of Richmond)

CTAF: 122.8 Runway 18/36: 4500 x 100 ft.

Total Tour Distance - Direct: 146.7 nautical miles / 168.7 statute miles.

Total Tour Distance - Diverting East Around Lexington Airspace: 150.3 nm / 172.8 sm.
